Intuitive Navigation

Standard Placement

- Horizontal vs. Vertical
- Order Matters



Descriptive Titles

- Describe what will be found in each section
- Avoid vague labels (i.e. "Services")
- Increased relevance with search engines



Limit Drop Down Menus

 Before moving the mouse, visitors have already made a decision about which menu item to click

Limit Menu Options

- Distill to 6-7 primary options
- Removing one label will increase the importance of the remaining options



Formatting Best Practices

Evenly Balanced Content

- Above/Below "The Fold"
- Break large paragraphs into shorter lines and lists










Text Formatting

 - Avoid using colors for text to emphasize importance. Instead, bold and underline.


